The Annual Congregational Meeting will be held on Sunday, November 23, 2025 following worship. Details to come in a letter to congregation members.

Pastor Rebecca continues to serve at Christ Lutheran on an interim basis through Dec 31, 2025. At their upcoming November meeting, Christ Council will recommend that there be a call vote at their Dec 6th congregational meeting. Moxham Lutheran voting members will also have a call vote at the Nov 23rd congregational meeting for Pastor to be first called leader of Living Waters Lutheran Parish. During these two congregational meetings, both congregations will also vote to approve the Parish Agreement. An Installation Service will take place Feb 15, 2026.
